1 month to go until the final of The Tall Ships Races!

Building stages, stands, and zones, making changes to the traffic organization, and most importantly, tracking the progress of our crew – this is the plan for the coming month. The busiest period of preparations for the final of The Tall Ships Races is ahead of us.

WHO WILL WIN THE RACE?



On June 30th, the sailing ships left Klaipėda, Lithuania, and began the big race. When they reach Helsinki, they will have completed the first leg of the race. The next one will start in Tallinn, to which the crews will sail on the so-called Cruise-in-Company. Before reaching Szczecin, they will make stops in Turku and Mariehamn. Thanks to the interactive race map on www.sailonboard, everyone can follow the race on their computer and smartphone screens. In addition to the current race results, by hovering the cursor over a particular vessel, you can get information about its speed, captain, and position in its class and in the overall ranking.

WHO WILL WE SEE IN SZCZECIN?



Nearly 70 vessels will take part in the regatta. The biggest sailing ships are the most impressive, but the smaller ones should not be underestimated. Yachts, which usually have about 10-person crews on board, demonstrate great resilience and a will to fight, and it is among them that fierce rivalry unfolds at sea.

The regatta in Szczecin will conclude with 43 participants. In addition, yachts and sailboats, as well as ships of the Polish Navy, will also dock

in our city, even though they do not participate in the race itself, but want to join us during the event! A total of around 65 vessels will be moored at the quays. Each of these guests has a unique story to tell. One of them is undoubtedly *Kapitan Głowacki*, which, after a 3.5-year reconstruction, was rechristened in May this year and returned to the seas. Participation in The Tall Ships Races is its first voyage in years. A vessel not to be missed will be the sailing ship *Guayas*, which will be visiting Szczecin for the first time.

KEEPING OUR FINGERS CROSSED FOR OUR TEAM!

Szczecin is represented by two ships, Dar Szczecina and Zryw. Together, they carry 30 young, adventurous and brave daredevils, most of whom are participating in a tall ships race for the first time. The Szczecin yachts are led by captains Wojciech Maleika and Jędrzej Owczarski, who have never returned to their home port without a trophy. We hope this year will be no different. The weather was not in their favour when they set sail from Szczecin on June 22nd, but we are confident that the sun will shine for them and the wind will always be in their sails.





A COLOURFUL PARADE TO END THE RACE



The Crew Parade is an international, colourful, and joyous procession that will pass through the streets of the city on Saturday, August 3rd at 3:00 PM. The parade will feature orchestras and crews from the sailing ships and yachts competing in The Tall Ships Races 2024. They can be recognized by their distinctive plaques with the names of their vessels and the flags of their countries.

The parade, coming from Chrobry Embankment to the Summer Theatre in Kasproicz Park, will be full of music, dancing, and artistic performances. This is how the crews will present themselves to the residents and tourists, creating an extraordinary, joyful, maritime atmosphere that will spread throughout the city!

MEDIA ACCREDITATIONS



From July 1st, applications will be accepted for media accreditation to cover the August finale of The Tall Ships Races 2024 in Szczecin.

Applications will be accepted until July 28th.

Accreditations will entitle to, among other things, use the press office located in the Focus Hotel and access the zone on the terrace above the fountain – near the statue of Hercules fighting the Centaur. We encourage you to fill in the online accreditation form available on The Tall Ships Races website.

An area for conversations and interviews will be available for interested media representatives on the viewing terrace near the Centaur statue. Additionally, press boats will be ready on the water. Cruises, enabling the production of video footage or taking photos from the water during the race, will take place throughout all days of the event. Participation in these will only be possible by prior booking at the press office.

FLIGHTS PROHIBITED



For safety reasons, the airspace over the Oder River will be closed during the August finale of The Tall Ships Races. **The flight ban will be in effect from 1 August from 10:00 to 5 August until 18:00.**

The ban will cover the area of the entire of the planned event, the access roads from the centre and the right bank. The zone will be created from the Wielecki Quay exit towards the city centre. Drones that fail to comply with the ban may be disabled or destroyed. Additionally, violating the ban may result in a fine, penalty of restricted liberty, or a year in prison.



**WATCH OUT
FOR CHANGES!**

Every outdoor event involves changes in traffic organization. Due to the finale of The Tall Ships Races, temporary traffic arrangements will be introduced around Chrobry Embankment and Łasztownia. The changes will be implemented in stages during the period 27.07-6.08. Residents of the streets where temporary arrangements are introduced will receive passes that allow them to access their homes. Similarly, companies operating in the affected areas will receive passes.

Passes will be available for collection at the Pass Issuance Office at Jana z Kolna Street in the former headquarters of Żegluga Szczecińska from July 19th at 10:00 AM.
